FB's SCHOOL WITHOUT WALLS' Bell Returned to Bell Tower as Renovation and Modernization of former Grant School Nears Completion

May 21st: The 1882 bell, restored by the Verdin Company, was returned to the School Without Walls, nee Grant School located at 2130 G St. NW. "This is another step in the respectful restoration and modernization of this 1880's building", says Terry Lynch, a Walls parent and member of the School Improvement Team. The school's original pine wood floors have been uncovered and are being restored, the school's masonry has been re-pointed, and its ornate metal staircase was to be restored. Other historical elements - long lost wooden front doors will be reproduced, as will wood wainscoting that was in all the classrooms.
