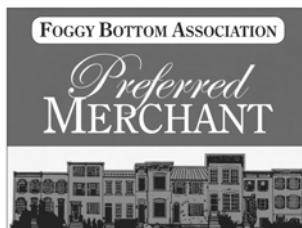

DEJA VU ALL OVER AGAIN?

In a flashback to July 2007, Mayor Fenty and Councilmember Jack Evans held a press conference Thursday to announce the issuance of a Request for Proposals for the redevelopment of three publicly-owned parcels in the West End. Back "in play" are the WE Library, MPD Special Ops station and Engine Co. #1 firehouse, <http://dcbiz.dc.gov>. Despite the lapse of virtually no notice, numerous community representatives and neighbors attended, demonstrating to our elected officials that the community expects to be an equal partner in a wholly transparent process. When it comes to our public assets, we expect nothing less.

SPORTS CLUB/LA

The Sports Club/LA is offering FBA members a corporate rate of \$1,419 for one year, the equivalent of \$118/month. That compares with the usual membership rate of \$2,366 (\$143/mo. plus a \$650 initiation fee), a first-year savings of \$947. Squash membership is \$1,639 for a year, vs. the standard \$2,706 (\$163/mo. plus a \$750 initiation fee). The membership must be paid in one payment.
